

RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-103

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A 2023 CHEVROLET EQUINOX AWD SPORTS UTILITY VEHICLE - (REPLACEMENT OF POLICE INVESTIGATIONS VEHICLE RM361/C702, 2016 FORD TAURUS) FROM CURRIE MOTORS IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$29,765

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows ("City") maintains the City's vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City has a long-term capital program that includes replacing vehicles and equipment as needed; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted for the replacement of RM361/C702 Police Investigations Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to replace equipment at recommended time intervals set by the vehicle replacement committee and the Public Works Department Vehicle Services Division; and

WHEREAS, due to guaranteed in-stock availability and minimal additional cost over contract price, the city waives formal bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, Currie Motors has provided a quote to the City for a total cost of \$29,765; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Budget provides \$35,000 in funding for this vehicle identified in account #01-30-3000-56000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the agreements and other necessary documents with Currie Motors to purchase one 2023 Chevrolet Equinox AWD SUV in an amount of \$29,765.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Currie Motors, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


