

RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-105

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A FORD F-150 4X4 PICK UP TRUCK FROM CURRIE MOTORS IN THE AMOUNT \$53,060 AND NECESSARY LIGHTING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,852.86 FROM FLEET SAFETY SUPPLY

WHEREAS, The City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) maintains the City’s vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City has a long-term capital program that includes replacing vehicles and equipment as needed; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted for the replacement of RM301/FD656 Command Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City’s best interest to replace equipment at recommended time intervals set by the City’s Vehicle Replacement Committee and Public Works Department Vehicle Services Division; and

WHEREAS, Currie Motors has provided a quote to the City for a total cost of \$53,060; and

WHEREAS, Fleet Safety Supply, who has worked with the city for all Police and Fire lighting projects, has provided a quote to the City for a total cost of \$14,852.86; and

WHEREAS, Due to guaranteed in-stock availability and difficulty procuring vehicles, City staff are recommending waiving formal bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Budget provides funding for this vehicle identified in account #25-40-5020-60035.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the agreements and other necessary documents with Currie Motors to purchase one 2023 Ford F-150 4x4 pickup truck in the not to exceed amount of \$53,060, and the purchase of all lighting and emergency equipment from Fleet Safety Supply in the not to exceed amount of \$14,852.86.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Currie Motors or Fleet Safety Equipment, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


