

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT FOR SALT DOME ROOF REPAIRS TO BULK STORAGE INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,625.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows ("City") maintains all city-owned facilities and is responsible for improvements on those facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, protection of the City's bulk stored salt is a requirement of the EPA; and

WHEREAS, Bulk Storage Inc. has completed and provided a complete assessment of the Salt Dome located at 3900 Berdnick Dr.; and

WHEREAS, Bulk Storage Inc. is the original builder of the Salt Dome; and

WHEREAS, Bulk Storage Inc. provided a quote for repairs in the amount of \$30,625.00; and

WHEREAS, the FY2023 budget provides funding for improvements to City Facilities within the Building and Land Fund (33-70-5050-60010).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the agreements and other necessary documents with Bulk Storage Inc. to perform repairs on the City's Salt Dome in the amount of \$30,625.00.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Bulk Storage Inc., such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).


Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


