

RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-113

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR SANITARY SEWER AND STORM SEWER REHABILITATION PIPE LINING WITH HOERR CONSTRUCTION, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$146,647.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) maintains sanitary sewer and storm water conveyance systems; and

WHEREAS, maintenance of the sanitary and storm water conveyance systems is the responsibility of the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the City is mandated by the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District (“MWRD”) to upkeep and make repairs to its sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Hoerr Construction, Inc. (“HCI”) has provided a proposal for the 2023 sanitary sewer and storm sewer rehabilitation pipe lining project in the amount of \$146,647.00; and

WHEREAS, staff is recommending HCI for the sanitary sewer and storm sewer rehabilitation pipe lining project because of their knowledge of the City’s infrastructure, and their past performance on projects within the City; and

WHEREAS, the FY2023 budget provides funding for the sanitary sewer and storm sewer rehabilitation pipe lining project in accounts 2070.5035.60020 and 2070.5040.60020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the agreements and other necessary documents with Hoerr Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$146,647.00 for the sanitary sewer and storm sewer rehabilitation pipe lining.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Hoerr Construction Inc., such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


