

RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-114

**A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR SANITARY SEWER
MANHOLE LINING AND REHABILITATION TO NATIONAL POWER
RODDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$94,235.00**

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) maintains sanitary sewer and storm water conveyance systems; and

WHEREAS, maintenance of the sanitary and storm water conveyance systems is the responsibility of the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, National Power Rodding (NPR) has provided a proposal for the 2023 sanitary sewer manhole lining and rehabilitation project in the amount of \$94,235.00; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director is recommending that the City’s past practice of utilizing NPR for sanitary sewer manhole lining and rehabilitation be continued because of the high quality of past workmanship along with their knowledge of the City’s infrastructure system and of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District compliance requirements; and

WHEREAS, the FY2023 Budget provides funding for the Sanitary Manhole Program in account 2070.5035.60020, in the amount of \$95,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the agreements and other necessary documents with NPR in the amount of \$94,235.00, for the sanitary sewer and storm sewer manhole lining.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with NPR, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


