

RESOLUTION NO. 24-R-14

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT TIRES AND SERVICES FOR FY2024 FROM POMP'S TIRE SERVICE IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$38,000

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows ("City") maintains the City's vehicle and equipment fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City routinely purchases vehicle and heavy equipment tires; and

WHEREAS, Pomp's Tire Service offers to store a significant quantity of the City's heavy-duty spare tires at no charge; and

WHEREAS, the City has had a great working relationship and reliable service from Pomp's Tire Service in the past; and

WHEREAS, the FY2024 Budget provides funding in the amount of \$38,000.00 for the purchase of and service of tires in account #14-70-5015-56255.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and to execute other necessary documents with pomp's Tire Service for the purchase vehicle and heavy equipment tires in a not to exceed amount of \$38,000.00.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Pomp's Tire Service, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


