

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) 2025 FORD UTILITY INTERCEPTOR CURRIE MOTORS IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$150,015.00 AND NECESSARY LIGHTING IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$39,000.00 FROM FLEET SAFETY SUPPLY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) maintains the City’s vehicle fleet; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has budgeted \$171,000.00 for the replacements of three (3) Police Patrol Vehicles in account # 25-3050-20-60032; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the City’s best interest to replace equipment at recommended time intervals set by the Vehicle Replacement Committee and Vehicle Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has a long-term capital program that includes replacing vehicles and equipment as needed; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has budgeted for the replacement of three police vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, Currie Motors has provided a quote to the City for a total cost of \$50,005.00 per vehicle, \$150,015.00 total; and

**WHEREAS**, Fleet Safety Supply, who has worked with the City for all Police and Fire lighting projects, has provided estimated costs of \$13,000.00 per vehicle, \$39,000.00 total, and

**WHEREAS**, the FY2024 Budget provides funding for the purchase of police vehicles in the Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

**Section 2. Approval.** The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and execute other necessary documents with Currie Motors for the purchase of three (3) police patrol vehicles in a not to exceed amount of \$150,015.00, and the purchase of all lighting and emergency equipment from Fleet Safety Supply in the not to exceed amount of \$39,000.00.

**Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding.** To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Fleet Safety Supply, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).


**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


