

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE IN ORDER TO ALLOW FOR THE CITY MANAGER’S EXECUTION OF GRANT AGREEMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS

WHEREAS, in order to prevent the loss of grant funding due to timing constraints related to the City’s approval of grant agreements, the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows deems it desirable, necessary and in the best interests of the City to amend the City Code related to the powers and duties of the City Manager in order to allow for the City Manager’s execution of grant agreements on behalf of the City of Rolling Meadows.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The recitals and statements set forth above are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2: Section 2-224, entitled “Powers and duties”, of Subdivision 1, entitled “In General”, of Division 3, entitled “City Manager”, of Article III, entitled “Officers”, of Chapter 2, entitled “Administration”, of the City Code of the City of Rolling Meadows is hereby amended to add a new paragraph 22, to read as follows:

(22) Approve, execute and deliver, on behalf of the city, grant agreements where the city’s expenditure under any such agreement is less than under \$100,000, with subsequent written notification to the city council. In the event a grant agreement requires the city’s expenditure of \$100,000 or more, the city council must approve or ratify the city manager’s execution of any such agreement pursuant to official action at a public meeting of the city council.


Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in accordance with law.




