

RESOLUTION NO. 24-R-70

A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO BEAR CONSTRUCTION TO PERFORM IMPROVEMENTS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT LOCKER ROOMS IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$160,000

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) Public Works Department is responsible for maintaining all city owned facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited sealed bids for the City Hall Improvements Project on August 9th and opened sealed bids on August 20, 2024 at 10:30 AM; and

WHEREAS, there were no bids submitted for the Locker Room improvements portion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City received a proposal from Bear Construction in May and has since revisited and revised that proposal to reflect a cost of \$160,000.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will come from the Building Improvements Account #33.70.5050.60010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents with Bear Construction to perform improvements to the Police Department Locker Rooms, in a not to exceed Amount of \$160,000.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Bear Construction, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


