

**ORDINANCE NO. 24-42**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE DATE AND HOURS OF  
TRICK-OR-TREATING FOR HALLOWEEN**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows has determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the City to amend the Code of Ordinances, City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois to establish a consistent date and hours of trick-or-treating associated with the celebration of Halloween.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1:** That Chapter 74, entitled “Peddlers, Solicitors and Canvassers” of the Code of Ordinances, City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois shall be amended by amending the title of Chapter 74 to read “ Peddlers, Solicitors and Canvassers, Including Halloween Regulations” and by adding a new Article III to Chapter 74 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE III. – TRICK-OR-TREATING ON HALLOWEEN**

**Sec. 74-50: Exclusion from Solicitation, Peddling and Canvassing**

The activity of trick-or-treating in the celebration of Halloween in accordance with this article, shall not have the meaning of to canvass, to peddle or to solicit as defined in this chapter.

**Sec. 74-51: Permissible Hours**

Each year trick-or-treating shall be permissible in the City of Rolling Meadows between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on October 31<sup>st</sup> in celebration of Halloween. Said hours shall be in effect each year unless the City Council passes a resolution for a particular year amending the hours for that particular year.

**Section 2:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage, approval and publication as required by law.

**PASSED AND APPROVED** by the City Council of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois this 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2024.




