

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A NEW CITY SEAL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-2-12 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/2-2-12 and its home rule authority under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, the City may “[...] have a corporate seal, changeable at pleasure [...]”; and

WHEREAS, the City’s previously adopted a corporate seal in 1961 and last modified its corporate seal in 1995; and

WHEREAS, the City is presently implementing a new logo and brand that is intended to respect the past and represent the future of Rolling Meadows; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the City of Rolling Meadows have therefore determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to adopt a new corporate seal incorporating the new brand as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois:

Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference as the findings of the Corporate Authorities.

Section 2: Section 2-1, entitled “Seal,” of Article I, entitled “In General,” of Chapter 2, entitled “Administration” of the Code of Ordinances, Rolling Meadows, Illinois shall be and is hereby amended as follows (additions are **bold and underlined** and deletions are ~~struck through~~ or shown in **red**):

“Sec. 2-1 Seal.

Pursuant to its home rule powers and 65 ILCS 5/2-2-12, the city adopts the following as its city seal and logo:



Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.




