

RESOLUTION NO. 25-R-06

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A 2026 AUTOCAR HEIL REFUSE TRUCK (REPLACEMENT OF RM368/T336 A 2017 AUTOCAR HEIL REFUSE TRUCK) FROM EJ EQUIPMENT IN AN AMOUNT OF \$381,574 AND DECLARING AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AN EXISTING REFUSE TRUCK FOR TRADE-IN

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted in account #25.70.5020.60039 in FY2025 for the replacement of RM368/T336 Refuse Truck consistent with an 8-year replacement cycle; and

WHEREAS, EJ Equipment has provided a quote to the City for a total cost of \$381,574 after applying a trade-in credit of \$40,000 pursuant to the Sourcewell Joint Purchasing Cooperative Contract #110223-THC, which has been competitively bid; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City and its residents to trade-in the RM368/T336 Refuse Truck and obtain a new Refuse Truck as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Approval of Purchase, Trade-In, and Surplus Property Declaration.

A. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents with EJ Equipment, Inc for purchasing one (1) 2026 Autocar Heil Refuse Truck ("*New Vehicle*") in an Amount of \$381,574.

B. Pursuant to the home rule powers of the City and the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the City Council finds that the RM368/T336 Refuse Truck, a 2017 Autocar bearing vehicle identification number 5VCACVF8HH222855 ("*Trade-In Vehicle*") will be no longer necessary or useful to the City after the purchase of the New Vehicle, and the best interests of the City will be served by conveying the Trade-In Vehicle as part payment on the new purchase of the New Vehicle. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to convey and transfer title of the Trade-In Vehicle as part payment concurrent with receipt of the New Vehicle by the City.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.

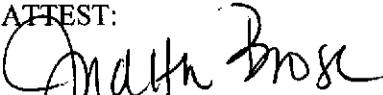
