

RESOLUTION 25-R-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DOMINION LIGHTING & SOLAR IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$47,769 FOR THE CONSULTANT, PROCUREMENT, AND INSTALLATION OF SEVEN (7) LEVEL TWO ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGERS LOCATED AT CITY HALL

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) has a vested interest in creating more sustainable energy sources and adding Electric Vehicles to the City’s fleet when practical and effective; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, in 2023 the City Council approved the Rolling Meadows Sustainability Plan which focuses on utilizing sustainable energy whenever practical; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating the City Hall site, staff found a need to increase the amount of available electric power on-site to increase the capacity for Electric Vehicle Chargers; and

WHEREAS, Dominion Solar & Lighting has provided a proposal in the amount of \$47,769 to work with ComEd to increase the available power, procure, and install the seven level 2 chargers; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted \$100,000 for the installation of electric vehicle infrastructure in account 33-70-5050-60010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents with Dominion Solar & Lighting for the Purchase, Procurement, and Installation of Electric Infrastructure and Seven (7) Electric Vehicle Chargers at City Hall.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Dominion Solar & Lighting, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).


Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.
