

RESOLUTION NO. 25-R-38

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A 2025 CHEVROLET TRAVERSE (REPLACEMENT OF POLICE INVESTIGATIONS VEHICLE RM361/C704, 2016 FORD TAURUS) THROUGH CURRIE MOTORS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$44,595.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) is responsible for the maintenance and management of its municipal vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle referenced in Resolution No. 25-R-20 was sold prior to the completion of the transaction authorized therein, rendering said resolution moot and no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City maintains a long-term capital improvement program that includes the planned replacement of vehicles and equipment to ensure operational efficiency and reliability; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City’s best interest to adhere to the recommended replacement intervals as outlined in the City’s Vehicle Replacement Policy; and

WHEREAS, funding has been allocated in the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget for the replacement of vehicle RM361/C704, assigned to the Police Investigations Division; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget includes an appropriation of \$45,000 for this vehicle purchase, as designated in account #25-30-5020-60032; and

WHEREAS, City staff obtained competitive quotes from three qualified vendors, with Currie Motors submitting the lowest responsive and responsible proposal; and

WHEREAS, Currie Motors has provided a quote in the amount of \$44,595.00 for the replacement vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents with Currie Motors to purchase one 2025 Chevrolet Traverse in an amount of \$44,595.00.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Currie Motors, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


