

RESOLUTION NO. 25-R-39

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A 2025 CHRYSLER PACIFICA MINIVAN (REPLACEMENT OF POLICE INVESTIGATIONS VEHICLE RM378/C701, 2017 DODGE CARAVAN) FROM WICKSTROM AUTO GROUP IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$57,489.32

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) is responsible for maintaining and managing its municipal vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle referenced in Resolution No. 25-R-19 was sold prior to the completion of the transaction authorized therein, thereby rendering said resolution obsolete and no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City implements a long-term capital improvement program that includes the scheduled replacement of vehicles and equipment to maintain operational effectiveness and public safety; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City’s best interest to replace vehicles in accordance with the intervals recommended in the City’s Vehicle Replacement Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget includes funding for the replacement of vehicle RM378/C701 assigned to the Police Investigations Division; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of \$60,000 has been designated for this purchase within Capital Account #25-30-5020-60032; and

WHEREAS, Wickstrom Auto Group has submitted a quote to the City in the amount of \$57,489.32 for the replacement vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents with Wickstrom Auto Group to purchase (1) 2025 Chrysler Pacifica minivan in an amount of \$57,489.32.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Wickstrom Auto Group, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


