

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE AWARD OF A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT TO PRE-FORM TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEMS FOR ANNUAL PAVEMENT MARKING SERVICES IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$70,000 PER YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) Public Works Department is responsible for maintenance of roadways within City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home-rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, road striping is a critical component of traffic control that ensures lane visibility, guides vehicle movement, and enhances pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows followed the City’s purchasing policy and solicited for sealed bids and received two sealed bids publicly read aloud on April 30th 2025; and

WHEREAS, Pre-Form Traffic Control Systems was the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget (61.70.5010.54640) provides funding in the amount of \$70,000 for street lane markings; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to enter into a three-year contract for 2025, 2026, and 2027 with Pre-Form Traffic Control Systems for the provision of annual pavement marking services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements and other necessary documents Pre-Form Traffic Control Systems for the services of road striping for a one-year term, with 2 one-year extension terms, in a not to exceed amount of \$70,000 for the first term of May 2025-June 2026, \$70,000 for the first renewal term of May 2026- June 2027, and \$70,000 for the second renewal term of May 2027-June 2028.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


