

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE STAFFING PLAN
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011 ASSISTANT TO THE CITY MANAGER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of Rolling Meadows, the City manager has reviewed and made recommendation on the salary ranges for each non-union class or position, which shall consist of an entrance level and a maximum with specific increments between, where applicable, and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 05-R-132 adopting the position of Assistant City Manager and striking the Assistant to the City Manager position; and

WHEREAS, Staff has determined that it is necessary to amend the Staffing Plan to strike the Assistant City Manager position and return to an Assistant to the City Manager position in the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the Staffing Plan for Fiscal Year 2011 is amended and revised by adding the position of Assistant to the City Manager as a full time position under Administration and the position and salary of Assistant City Manager be stricken.

SECTION TWO: That the classification for Assistant to the City Manager is hereby created with a salary of \$ 35,750. The City Manager shall have the authority to increase this salary on January 1 of 2013 and each subsequent calendar year by a percentage not larger than the December year-to-year inflation rate as published by the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


