

**Ordinance No. 11-63**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS**

**WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and 5 ILCS 220/1-8 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes authorize and encourage intergovernmental cooperation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Obenauf Auction Service, located at, 118 N Orchard Street Round Lake IL 60073 is an auction company that organizes joint municipal auctions of surplus property, and

**WHEREAS**, in the opinion of a majority of the Corporate Authorities of the City of Rolling Meadows, it is no longer necessary, useful, or in the best interest of said jurisdiction to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the City Council finds that the following described personal property now owned by the City of Rolling Meadows is no longer necessary or useful or in the best interest of the City to maintain, and the City would be best served by the sale of said personal property.:

**SECTION TWO:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to direct the sale of the aforementioned personal property through an online auction conducted by Obenauf Auction Service.

**SECTION THREE:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to direct the Obenauf Auction Service to advertise the sale of the aforementioned personal

property through the area newspapers, direct mailings and other channels deemed appropriate prior to the date of said auction.

**SECTION FOUR:** The City Manager is authorized to direct Obenauf Auction Service to enter into an agreement for the sale of said property whereby said property is sold at the auction.

**SECTION FIVE:** No bid shall be accepted for the sale of an item which is less than the \$1.00 minimum value set forth herein, unless the City Manager or his designee so authorizes at the time of the auction.

**SECTION SIX:** Upon payment in full of the auctioned price for aforesaid items of personal property by the highest bidder, the City Manager is authorized to direct Obenauf Auction Service to convey and transfer the title and ownership of said personal property to the bidder.

**SECTION SEVEN:** In the event any item is not sold at such public auction, the City Manager is further authorized and directed to dispose of such items by any other means at such price to be determined by the City Manager.

Items included for disposal include the following:

**SECTION EIGHT:** In the event that any of the items set forth in Section Seven are not sold, they may be disposed of as the City Manager sees fit at a private or public sale, donation or disposal.

**SECTION NINE:** This ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the Rolling Meadows City Council.

**SECTION TEN:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.


