

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR CODE

Whereas, the City Code of Ordinances currently does not provide for a Class P Liquor License; and

Whereas, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to create a Class P Liquor License and authorize one (1) such license.

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: Sec. 6-36, Classification of licenses for retail sale, is amended in part to read as follows:

(h) Class P licenses shall authorize the retail delivery or sale of alcoholic liquor in any building owned by the Rolling Meadows Park District, the delivery and sale of alcoholic liquor in which has been approved by the board of commissioners of the park district pursuant to Section 6-15 of the Illinois Liquor control Act of 1934. Such retail delivery or sale may be by the park district or by an entity with whom the park district has contracted to provide professional catering or other food and beverage service services. Class P license holders may permit social dancing and live music on the premises.

Section Two: Subparagraph (a) of Sec. 6-37, Restriction on Number and Classification of Licenses, of Chapter 6, "Alcoholic Beverages," is amended in part to read as follows:

(8) One Class P License

Section Two: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.


Section Three: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows.




