

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A SPECIAL USE
(PACE BUS SERVICE)**

WHEREAS, on November 11, 1997, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 97-82 granting a Special Use for four (4) off-premise bus shelters along Golf Road; and

WHEREAS, Pace has requested the City to amend the Special Use to allow the four (4) existing bus shelters to have an ad style shelter and to allow two (2) additional bus shelters at Golf Road and Ring Road and at Golf Road and Gould Drive, which would also have the ad style shelter; and

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2011, the Plan Commission conducted a public hearing for the purpose of considering amending the Special Use to allow six (6) ad style bus shelters; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission conducted a public hearing on the Amendment to the Special Use after notice of public hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has submitted its report and recommendation to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has submitted its report and recommendation to grant the Amendment to the Special Use to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, which report has been considered by the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council having received the minutes, recommendation and findings of fact of the Plan Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the evidence is such as to establish the following beyond a reasonable doubt:

That the proposed use at the particular location required is necessary or desirable to provide a service or a facility which is in the interest of public convenience and will constitute to the general welfare of the neighborhood or the community; and

That such use will not under the circumstances of the particular case, be detrimental to the health, safety, morals or general welfare of persons residing or working in the vicinity, or injurious to property values or improvements in the vicinity; and

That the proposed use will comply with the regulations and the conditions specified in the City's Comprehensive Zoning Code for such use and with the stipulations and conditions made a part of the authorization granted by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois:

SECTION ONE: Pace is hereby granted an amendment to its Special Use to allow to six

(6) ad style bus shelters at the following locations:

- A. Northwest corner of Golf and Ring Roads;
- B. Southwest corner at 2849 Golf Road;
- C. Northwest corner at 2900 Golf Road;
- D. Southeast corner of Golf and New Wilke Roads;
- E. Southwest corner of Golf and Ring Roads; and
- F. Northeast corner of Golf and New Wilke Roads one (1) block east New Wilke.

SECTION TWO: The amendment to the Special Use is subject to the following:

- A. The City shall have final approval of the shelter location (with IDOT concurrence if applicable). If any future visibility obstruction occurs, the advertising signage and/or shelter shall be adjusted accordingly.
- B. Pace following the recommendations of the Rolling Meadows Traffic Review Committee as stated in a memo dated February 15, 2011. The recommendation was for the proposed advertising bus shelter at the SWC of Golf & Ring Roads (EB) be either moved to the east side of the intersection or have a site distance analysis per IDOT guidelines be performed and adjust the shelter location accordingly. The same recommendation was suggested for the existing shelter at Lois Drive and Golf Road.

- C. Each advertising bus shelter shall have nighttime illumination (solar-power).
- D. The signage shall be in accordance with the City of Rolling Meadows regulations specific to bus shelters.
- E. A new lease agreement for the bus shelters shall be executed between the city and Pace.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval as required by law.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.






