

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 106 "TRAFFIC"

WHEREAS, the City currently has weight restrictions on certain streets within the City and the Illinois Legislature recently amended the weight restrictions from 36 tons to 40 tons; and

WHEREAS, certain streets are either no longer under the jurisdiction of the City or have recently been built and need to be included in the list of streets which are to be excepted from the weight restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: Section 106-29 of Chapter 106, "Traffic" is hereby repealed.

Section Two: Chapter 106, "Traffic" is hereby amended by adding thereto, the following:

Sec. 106-29. Special weight limitations on certain streets.

(a) The City Council prohibits the operation of any vehicle whose gross weight, loaded or unloaded, exceeds the maximum of ten tons per vehicle on any street under its jurisdiction with the exception of the following streets where the weight limit will be 40 tons:

- (1) Apollo Drive
- (2) Berdnick Street
- (3) Carnegie Street
- (4) Edison Place
- (5) Golf Place
- (6) Hicks Road

- (7) Industrial Avenue
- (8) Keystone Court
- (9) Kirchoff Road
- (10) Lois Drive
- (11) Meacham/Plum Grove Road – South of Emerson
- (12) Meadowbrook Drive and Meadowbrook Industrial Court
- (13) Meijer Drive Industrial Use/Truck Route
- (14) New Wilke Road – Algonquin Road to Golf Road
- (15) Newport Drive
- (16) Plum Grove Road
- (17) Rohlwing Road
- (18) Squibb Avenue
- (19) Tollview Drive
- (20) Weber Drive – southbound
- (21) Wilke Road from Euclid Avenue to Kirchoff Road

The weight limits set forth above shall not apply to fire and emergency vehicles, city owned trucks or trucks engaged in city business within the city, public passenger vehicles (buses), public utility vehicle, refuse and recycling trucks engaged in the collection of material, and delivery vehicles for a distance of one highway mile to or from a class II highway on any street or highway, unless there is a sign prohibiting the access or five highway miles on a street or highway in the system of state highways, and upon any street or highway designated by the city council or road district commissioners, to points of loading and unloading and facilities for food, fuel, repairs and rest.

(b) The city shall erect or shall cause to be erected and maintained the signs designating the provisions of the ordinance of special weight limitations at all streets that intersect any street affected, and the ordinance shall not be effective unless and until such signs are erected and maintained.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.






