

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE
ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS**

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the City of Rolling Meadows conducted a public hearing on February 7, 2012, regarding the proposed amendment to permit Temporary Construction and Home Improvement Services Signs, in each of the Residential Zoning Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission did conduct the above public hearing after appropriate notice as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has submitted its report, and recommendation in writing, to the Mayor and City Council of the City, which recommendation is to allow Temporary Construction and Home Improvement Services Signs in each of the Residential Zoning Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 122-122(s)(1) of the Comprehensive Zoning Code is hereby amended to add the following:

- f. Temporary Construction and Home Improvement Services Signs, subject to the following conditions:
1. Not more than one (1) sign per premise shall be allowed.
 2. No sign shall be erected prior to the beginning of the construction and once the work is complete, the sign must be removed.
 3. Signs identifying contractors or home improvement services shall not exceed 4 square feet per sign face advertising the name of the company providing the service and any additional contact information for such service only.
 4. Such signs shall be located no closer than fifteen (15) feet to the property line.
 5. A permit shall be required for such sign.

SECTION TWO: Section 122-124(o) of the Comprehensive Zoning Code is hereby amended by adding thereto, the following:

(4) Temporary Construction and Home Improvement Services Signs, subject to the following conditions:

1. Not more than one (1) sign per premise shall be allowed.
2. No sign shall be erected prior to the beginning of the construction and once the work is complete, the sign must be removed.
3. Signs identifying contractors or home improvement services shall not exceed 4 square feet per sign face advertising the name of the company providing the service and any additional contact information for such service only.
4. Such signs shall be located no closer than fifteen (15) feet to the property line.
5. A permit shall be required for such sign.

SECTION THREE: Section 122-126(r)(1) of the Comprehensive Zoning Code is hereby amended by adding thereto, the following:

f. Temporary Construction and Home Improvement Services Signs, subject to the following conditions:

1. Not more than one (1) sign per premise shall be allowed.
2. No sign shall be erected prior to the beginning of the construction and once the work is complete, the sign must be removed.
3. Signs identifying contractors or home improvement services shall not exceed 4 square feet per sign face advertising the name of the company providing the service and any additional contact information for such service only.
4. Such signs shall be located no closer than fifteen (15) feet to the property line.
5. A permit shall be required for such sign.

SECTION FOUR: Section 122-127(r)(1) of the Comprehensive Zoning Code is hereby amended by adding thereto, the following:

e. Temporary Construction and Home Improvement Services Signs, subject to the following conditions:

1. Not more than one (1) sign per premise shall be allowed.

2. No sign shall be erected prior to the beginning of the construction and once the work is complete, the sign must be removed.
3. Signs identifying contractors or home improvement services shall not exceed 4 square feet per sign face advertising the name of the company providing the service and any additional contact information for such service only.
4. Such signs shall be located no closer than fifteen (15) feet to the property line.
5. A permit shall be required for such sign.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows.


SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.


