

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
COMPREHENSIVE ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF ROLLING
MEADOWS**

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the City of Rolling Meadows conducted a public hearing on February 7, 2012 regarding the proposed amendment to permit Physical Fitness Centers , not to exceed 7,500 square feet in size, in the T-1 and C-1, C-2 and C-3 Zoning Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission did conduct the above public hearings after appropriate notice as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has submitted its report, and recommendation in writing, to the Mayor and City Council of the City, which recommendation is to add Physical Fitness Centers, not to exceed 7,500 square feet in size, as permitted uses in the T-1, C-1, C-2 and C-3 Zoning Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 122-187(b) of the Comprehensive Zoning Code is hereby is hereby amended to add the following:

(72) Physical Fitness Centers not to exceed 7,500 square feet in size.

SECTION TWO: Section 122-194(b) of the Comprehensive Zoning Code is hereby is hereby amended to add the following:

(56) Physical Fitness Centers not to exceed 7,500 square feet in size.

SECTION THREE: Section 122-156(b) (12) of the Comprehensive Zoning Code is hereby is hereby amended to add the following after "Health Clubs":

and Physical Fitness Centers not to exceed 7,500 square feet in size.

SECTION FOUR : This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows.






