Ordinance No. 12-29

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 58
“LAW ENFORCEMENT” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to provide the Chief of Police with the ability to hire part-time officers; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Code of Ordinances to provide for the Chief of Police to hire part-time police officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 58, “Law Enforcement” of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended at Section 58-32, by adding thereto, the following:

The Chief of Police shall have the ability to hire part-time police officers as he may from time to time deem appropriate.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows.
