

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70 “OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City Code of Ordinances provides at Chapter 70, Section 70-157(a) for the offense of truancy for persons less than 16 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the State legislature has amended the State statute to increase the age requirement for persons to attend school to persons less than age 18 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to amend the City’s Code of Ordinances to be consistent with the State statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 70, “Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions”, Section 70-157(a) of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting “under the age of 16” and inserting in lieu thereof “under the age of 18”.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows.


SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.




