

**Ordinance No. 13-05**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows has a canine unit as part of its police department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is no longer in the City's best interest to maintain a canine unit; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of 3/4ths of the corporate authorities, it is no longer necessary, useful, or in the best interest of the City to retain the one (1) canine in the City's canine unit; and

WHEREAS, the canine's caretaker has agreed to keep the dog as his own personal property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 and the City's Code of Ordinances, the corporate authorities find that the City's canine is no longer necessary or useful or in the best interest of the City to maintain and the City would be best served by selling the canine to its caregiver, Stephen Whetstone for \$1.00.

Section Two: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval in the manner as provided by law.






