

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 "CODE HEARING  
UNIT ADJUDICATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, Section 11-208.3 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208.3), expressly authorizes municipalities to provide by ordinance for a system of administrative adjudication of standing, parking and compliance violations for vehicles; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

Section One: Section 3-51. Procedure (2) (e) of Chapter 3, "Administrative Adjudication of Vehicular Standing, Parking and Compliance Violations" of the City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to be as follows:

(2) (e) Hearing Date: A section entitled "Hearing Date" which shall clearly set forth that the registered owner or lessee of the vehicle must appear at the initial administrative hearing to contest the validity of the violation notice on the date and at the time and place as specified and that you do not need to appear at this hearing if you are paying the fine/fee. If you are contesting the violation, or fail to pay the fine/fee prior to the hearing date, you **must** appear.

Section Two: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.


Section Three: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.




