

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2014 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2014
FOR THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That the sum of \$10,839,630 being the aggregate of appropriations exclusive of the estimated revenues from sources other than general taxation wherefore legally made, which are to be collected from the Tax Levy for the Fiscal Year beginning January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014 , of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois, appropriated for the current Fiscal Year by the official budget of the City of Rolling Meadows, as approved by the Mayor and City Council be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the City of Rolling Meadows, subject to taxation for the current Fiscal Year. The said appropriations and the estimated revenue from sources other than general taxation, the amounts of which have been ascertained, are as follows:

for Police Protection --	\$ 1,810,905
for Fire Protection --	\$ 1,810,905
for Public Works Ops --	\$ 524,501
for Police Pension --	\$ 2,478,905
for Fire Pension --	\$ 2,662,914
<u>for IMRF Pension --</u>	<u>\$ 1,000,000</u>
General Fund	\$ 10,288,130
<u>for E911 Service --</u>	<u>\$ 551,500</u>

Total General Fund & 911 Fund: \$10,839,630

SECTION TWO: The property tax levy limitation so imposed by Section 2-407 of the Codified Code of City Ordinances is hereby waived.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.


SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as provided by law.


