

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 110, "UTILITIES"**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources has amended the Lake Michigan Water Allocation Rules and Regulations to require that municipalities which receive Lake Michigan water provide, by ordinance, for restrictions to non-essential outside water use and;

WHEREAS, THE City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to adopt the amendments to the City's Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 110 "Utilities", Section 11-0201(b) is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

(b) From and after May 15 of each year, to and including September 15 of each year, no lawn sprinkling or irrigation, including but not limited to the use of automatic sprinklers or handheld hoses, attended or unattended of City water shall be permitted during the six (6) hour period in the middle of the day from 12 p.m. through 6 p.m. nor shall any such sprinkling or irrigation be permitted on any two consecutive days. New lawns (less than 3 months old) may be exempted from this provision.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval as required by law.


SECTION THREE This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.
