

ORDINANCE NO. 17-28

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 106 "TRAFFIC"
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the City has previously adopted portions of the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code;
and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to
adopt the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code, by reference, to eliminate the need to revise the Code of
Ordinances with each amendment to the Illinois Vehicle Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Rolling
Meadows, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 3-37 of the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 3 " Code Hearing
Adjudication" is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

Sec. 3-37. - Creation of code hearing unit; jurisdiction.

There is hereby created within the city a code hearing unit, which is authorized to provide
for and operate a "system of administrative adjudication," which shall be defined as the
adjudication of a violation of any ordinance of the City of Rolling Meadows, including any and
all violations of city vehicular standing, parking and condition of vehicle regulation (compliance)
violations, municipal wheel tax licenses and solid waste disposal fees as provided in chapter 90,
"solid waste," section 90-77, within the city as may be allowed by law. Violations of vehicular
standing, parking, condition of vehicle and wheel tax regulations shall be adjudicated in accord
with the provisions set forth in chapter 3, sections 3-47 through 3-66, of this Code.
Notwithstanding the foregoing, proceedings not within the statutory or home rule authority of the

city, offenses under the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/1-100 et seq.) or similar City of Rolling Meadows offenses that are traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles, reportable offenses under sections 6-204 and 15-111 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, and violations of city ordinances which, upon conviction or finding of guilt are punishable by a fine and a period of incarceration, shall not be subject to adjudication under this article II. In addition, actions brought pursuant to authority granted by section 5/7-5 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act (235 ILCS 5/7-5) shall be heard and adjudicated exclusively by the local liquor control commissioner of the City of Rolling Meadows.

Violation of chapter 70, article V, division 2, "clean indoor air" shall be within the jurisdiction of and shall be adjudicated by the code hearing unit.

Fines imposed for false alarms as provided in chapter 34, emergency services, shall be within the jurisdiction of the code hearing unit.

Violations of chapter 42 of the Code of Ordinances shall be within the jurisdiction of and shall be adjudicated by the code hearing unit.

Violations of division 1 of chapter 38.

Violation of chapter 102, "taxation" shall be within the jurisdiction of and shall be adjudicated by the code hearing unit.

Violations of chapter 70, section 70-44.

Violations of chapter 38, article IV—Small Unmanned Aircraft.

Violations of chapter 86 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION TWO: Article II, or Chapter 106, "Traffic", is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

Article II – Illinois Motor Vehicle Code:

Section 106-49. The City Council hereby adopts and incorporates herein, by reference, the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/1-100, et seq.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval as required by law.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.


