

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY
OWNED BY THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of a majority of the Corporate Authorities of the City of Rolling Meadows, it is no longer necessary, useful, or in the best interest of said jurisdiction to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the City Council finds that the personal property set forth on the attached Equipment Disposal List, (Exhibit "A"), now owned by the City of Rolling Meadows is no longer necessary or useful or in the best interest of the City to maintain and the City would be best served by the property's disposal.

SECTION TWO: The City Manager is hereby authorized to direct the sale and/or disposal of the aforementioned personal property through an authorized auction service, or by other means.

SECTION THREE: In the event any item is not sold at such public auction, the City Manager is further authorized and directed to dispose of such items by private sale or auction at such price to be determined by the City Manager.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a vote of at least three-fourths (3/4ths) of the corporate authorities, and approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
