

ORDINANCE NO. 17-24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO COMMUNICATIONS WATER TOWER LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN T-MOBILE CENTRAL, L.L.C. AND THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, T-Mobile is in the business of constructing, maintaining, and operating a telecommunications system; and

WHEREAS, T-Mobile wishes to locate, place, attach, install, operate, and maintain additional telecommunications equipment on municipal facilities owned by the City of Rolling Meadows at 3207 Central Road; and

WHEREAS, T-Mobile has requested that the City of Rolling Meadows enter into a First Amendment to Communications Water Tower Lease Agreement providing for the terms and conditions of T-Mobile's lease of the City's facilities.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of a three-fourths majority of the corporate authorities of the City of Rolling Meadows, it is advisable, necessary and in the public interest that the City of Rolling Meadows enter into the First Amendment to Communications Water Tower Lease Agreement with T-Mobile.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Mayor and City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver on behalf of the City of Rolling Meadows the First Amendment to Communications Water Tower Lease Agreement with T-Mobile Central, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval as required by law.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council.


