

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A REVISED FIVE-YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR THE COOK COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Rolling Meadows City Council placed public notice, and conducted -public hearings on November 24, 2009, January 12, 2010 and January 26, 2010 inviting applications for use of Community Development Block Grant funds, administered through the Cook County government; and

WHEREAS, proposals have been submitted and have been evaluated by City staff members to determine whether said projects meet the criteria established for Community Development Block Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, Rolling Meadows City staff members have included proposed projects into a draft Five-Year Plan, depicting the timeframe for completion of proposed projects and presented the same to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Rolling Meadows City Council conducted a public hearing on the proposed Five-Year Plan on February 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Rolling Meadows Park District has requested a revision to the most recently approved (February 9, 2010 - Resolution # 10-R-14) Five-Year Consolidated Plan to include as "Priority #2" a proposed project for heating, ventilation and air conditioning improvements for the Community Center, located 3705 Pheasant Drive.


