A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FIRE STATION AT 2301 ALGONQUIN ROAD UTILIZING MATCHING FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS STATION CONSTRUCTION GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT

WHEREAS, the fire department has demonstrated that they are unable to meet National Fire Protection Association Standards and department response time performance objectives in districts 115, 116, 331 and 332, located primarily in the southern portion of the City, which clearly demonstrates the need for a third fire station, and

WHEREAS, the City issued General Obligation Bonds in 2007 which included an allotment for the construction of Fire Station #17 and those funds are currently available in Fund 83, Fire Station Fund.

WHEREAS, a grant has been awarded by the Department of Homeland Security's Firefighters Station Construction Grant program submitted under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, and

WHEREAS, these federal grant funds along with the Bond funds will allow the City of Rolling Meadows to construct an additional fire station to improve fire and emergency medical responses in the southern portion of the City, and

WHEREAS, the construction of this facility will commence no later than spring of 2011 in compliance with the performance period of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois, that city staff be authorized construct a fire station utilizing matching federal grant funds awarded in the amount of \$1,157,000.00, with construction to commence no later than the spring of 2011.




