

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING EXCESS SURPLUS FROM IPBC BE ALLOCATED TO THE CITY AND PLACED IN THE GENERAL AND HEALTH INSURANCE FUNDS

WHEREAS, it is a matter of good public policy to have cash reserves for the general fund as said cash reserves alleviate cash flow requirements throughout the year, and in times of limited revenue receipts, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to replenish the City's overall reserves, and

WHEREAS, with the upcoming retirements of numerous employees in the City, and

WHEREAS, for the overall health of the City in upcoming years, and

WHEREAS, there is limited surplus held on behalf of the City at IPBC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, that City Staff is directed to request \$500,000 from IPBC to be placed into the City's hands.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said money be distributed as follows: \$100,000 to the General Fund and \$400,000 to the Health Insurance Fund.
