

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT AWARD FOR ASPHALT PAVEMENT PATCHING (DAWNGATE LANE AND GROUSE LANE)

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director is recommending that the City utilize a written proposal process for obtaining unit prices for the asphalt pavement patching of two City streets (Dawngate Lane, Grouse Lane).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Rolling Meadows City Council finds the public's interest would be served by waiving a formal bidding requirement for the grinding and resurfacing of asphalt pavement on Dawngate Lane and Grouse Lane, totaling an estimated 1,564 square yards.


SECTION TWO: The City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, accepts the proposal submitted by Glander Paving Company, 303 North Eric Drive, Palatine, Illinois 60067 for the proposed 1, 564 square yards of pavement grinding and resurfacing, at a unit cost of \$15.50 per square yard, total cost \$24,245 (lowest cost proposal of six proposals received). Funding to be provided from the Motor Fuel Tax Fund (\$19,000) and the Local Roads Fund (\$5,245).


