

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE
FIVE-YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR THE COOK
COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Rolling Meadows City Council placed public notice, and conducted public hearings on January 10, 2012 and January 24, 2012 inviting applications for use of Community Development Block Grant funds, administered through the Cook County government; and

WHEREAS, proposals have been submitted and have been evaluated by City staff members to determine whether said projects meet the criteria established for Community Development Block Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, Rolling Meadows City staff members have included proposed projects into a draft Five-Year Plan, depicting the timeframe for completion of proposed projects and presented the same to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Rolling Meadows City Council conducted a public hearing on the proposed Five-Year Plan on February 14, 2012.


