

**A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE APPLICATION OF ASPHALT PAVEMENT REJUVENATOR MATERIALS (PRA PRODUCT) ON SELECTED CITY STREETS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Director is recommending that the City utilize CAM, LLC North because of the quality of the product they offer, the limited number of quality vendors, and the highly satisfactory product application and performance of previous years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** The Rolling Meadows City Council finds the public's interest would be served by waiving a formal bidding requirement for the purchase and application of certain asphalt pavement rejuvenator products and where bidding would otherwise be required for Public Works services contracts exceeding \$20,000.

**SECTION TWO:** The City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, accepts the proposal from CAM, LLC North for supply and application of an estimated 40,207 square yards of Reclamite Preservative Seal, at an estimated total cost of \$28,949.04, at the unit price of \$0.72 per square yard. Funding is to be provided from the Local Roads Fund #61.


**SECTION THREE:** The locations of the streets to receive product application are planned to be: Arrowwood Lane (Millcreek to Millstone), Creekside Drive (West Frontage to Crestwood), Kingfisher Lane (Oriole to Martin), Kingfisher Court, Martin Lane (Meadow to Hawk), Barker Avenue (Central to Algonquin), Heron Court, School Drive (Campbell to Fremont), Oriole Lane (Kirchoff to Hawk), Rhiannon Court, Villa Circle, Bent Creek (Hartung to terminus), the Emerson Avenue Bikepath, and the Quentin Road Bikepath.


