

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS AND THE
VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON HEIGHTS FOR COMMUTER DRIVE – PHASE III
BIKEPATH AND ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION AND
CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING SERVICES**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, that the document titled “Intergovernmental Agreement for Commuter Drive – Bikepath and Roadway Phase III Engineering Services”, between the City of Rolling Meadows and the Village of Arlington Heights for the proposed pavement improvements and bikepath development, from Rohlwing Road to the west end of the Arlington Park-Metra Train Station parking lot, including curb and gutter repairs where required, and storm sewers where required, and all related work as designed by the City of Rolling Meadows Project Engineer (Ciorba Group, Ltd.) and the Village of Arlington Heights Department of Engineering, is hereby approved as presented, and as approved by the City Attorney.

The Intergovernmental Agreement provides for payment of Phase III engineering design services incurred by the City of Rolling Meadows and by the Village of Arlington Heights, in equal shares to each municipality, at approximately 20% “local agency” cost for bikepath construction engineering, and 20% “local agency” cost for roadway construction engineering, and 20% “local agency” cost for the bikepath and the roadway construction.

- The cost for construction engineering services is to be established at \$145,570.

(80% federal funding; cost to City of Rolling Meadows and Village of Arlington Heights = \$14,557 each.)

- The estimated costs of construction are:
 - 1.) Roadway - \$960,056 (10% each by Rolling Meadows and Arlington Heights = \$96,005 each)
 - 2.) Bikepath - \$570,307 (10% each by Rolling Meadows and Arlington Heights = \$57,031 each)
 - 3.) Land Acquisition - \$344,000 (10% each by Rolling Meadows and Arlington Heights = \$34,400 each) for Union Pacific Railroad property.

Funding for this project engineering and construction is to be provided by the FY2013 budget – Fund 61 Local Roads and Streets.


