

RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE PROPOSED GOLF ROAD BIKEPATH WITH THE VILLAGE OF SCHAUMBURG FOR PHASE III CONSTRUCTION AND CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) and the Village of Schaumburg (“Village”) wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (Exhibit “A”) for design engineering of a proposed bikepath along portions of property commonly known as the Golf Road corridor between Ring Road and Roosevelt Boulevard (as shown in Exhibit 1 within the Intergovernmental Agreement and attached herein); and

WHEREAS, the Village has received approval for the recipient of a federal grant administered by the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) – Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) which will provide the City and Village up to 80% for the cost of Phase II engineering services, Phase III engineering services, and construction cost; and

WHEREAS, the City and Village propose to share in the 20% local match/agency cost of the Phase III Construction and Construction Engineering costs Design Engineering and other undertakings by the parties as set forth in said Intergovernmental Agreement.




