

A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE APPLICATION OF ASPHALT PAVEMENT REJUVENATOR MATERIALS (PRA PRODUCT) ON SELECTED CITY STREETS IN 2017

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director is recommending that the City utilize CAM, LLC North because of the quality of the product they offer, the limited number of quality vendors, and the highly satisfactory product application and performance of previous years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Rolling Meadows City Council finds the public's interest would be served by waiving a formal bidding requirement for the purchase and application of certain asphalt pavement rejuvenator products and where bidding would otherwise be required for Public Works services contracts exceeding \$20,000.

SECTION TWO: The City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, accepts the proposal from CAM, LLC North for supply and application of approximately 32,358 square yards of Reclamite Preservative Seal, at an estimated total cost of \$24,915.66, based on the unit price of \$0.77 per square yard. Funding is to be provided from the Local Roads Fund #61.

SECTION THREE: The locations of the streets to receive product application are planned to be: Bobolink Lane, Creekside Drive, Dove Court, Dove Street – Hawk to Grouse, Grove Street – Wilke to Dove, Hawk Court, Hawk Lane – Pheasant to Meadow, Heron Court, Killarney Court, Kingfisher Court, Kingfisher Lane – Oriole to Martin, Lark Court, Maple Court, Maple Lane, Oriole Lane – Kirchoff to Hawk, Park Court, Redwing Court, Sigwalt Street – Cardinal to Flicker, Spruce Court, and Tern Court.
