

A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR PHASE 2 OF THE WATER SYSTEM SCADA TELEMETRY PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director is recommending that the City's use of Concentric Integration, for the equipment, design, programming and installation of SCADA telemetry improvements be authorized because of the uniqueness of the services they offer, the quality of their expertise and technical support, their familiarity with this instrumentation and service standardization, and with their performance in Phase I of the project in 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Rolling Meadows City Council finds the public's interest would be served by waiving a formal bidding requirement to perform the Water System SCADA programming upgrades.

SECTION TWO: The City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, accepts the estimate submitted by Concentric Integration, 8678 Ridgefield Road, Crystal Lake, IL 60012 to provide the equipment, design, programming and integration of the proposed SCADA telemetry improvements be authorized, per the proposal dated January 29, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$84,800.00.
