

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-R-18**

**AUTHORIZE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR CONGESTION AND AIR QUALITY PROGRAM (CMAQ) FUNDS FOR QUENTIN ROAD/HARTUNG ROAD BIKE PATH**

**WHEREAS**, federal grant funding is available through the CMAQ program administered by the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning; and

**WHEREAS**, CMAQ funds are to be utilized to fund projects that enhance the transportation system by reducing traffic congestion and providing improved air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rolling Meadows has plans to complete the partially built bike path on the east side of Quentin Road, from Highland Drive to Hartung Road (including the crossing of Salt Creek), and on the north side of Hartung Road, from Quentin Road to Fox Lane, with a total preliminary estimated cost of \$650,000; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed improvement project is eligible for funding by the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program, administered by the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION ONE:** An application be made to the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning for a financial assistance grant in the estimates amount of up to \$600,000, which is approximately 80% of the total estimated cost, under Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program for the purpose of funding the Quentin Road/Hartung Road Bike Path; and

**SECTION TWO:** The City of Rolling Meadows will provide 100% local matching funds in the estimated amount of \$53,436 for the proposed project Phase I Engineering; expected costs for Phase II and III engineering services and construction to be incurred in FY2020, FY2021, and FY2022; and

**SECTION THREE:** The Mayor of the City of Rolling Meadows is hereby authorized and directed to execute and submit on behalf of the Rolling Meadows such application.
