

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-R-21**

**AUTHORIZE CITY MANAGER AND/OR CITY ATTORNEY TO ADVISE THE NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL THAT THE CITY DID NOT AUTHORIZE THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2019, the City Manager first learned from an Article in the Journal & Topics that a Road to Zero grant application was filed, on behalf of the City of Rolling Meadows, with the National Safety Council; and

WHEREAS, the application, according to the newspaper article, appears to have been filed by Alderman Gallo on or before January 25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, at no time prior to February 1, 2019 was the Mayor, City Manager or department heads aware of the grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City, as of February 7, 2019, had not been provided with a requested copy of the grant application or documents indicating the terms or conditions of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council did not authorize any individual, commission or committee to submit the grant application on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to advise the National Safety Council that the City Council did not authorize the Road to Zero grant application.


