

RESOLUTION NO. 19-R-52

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A REFERENDUM QUESTION TO LIMIT THE TERMS OF AN ALDERMAN TO TWO (2) CONSECUTIVE TERMS

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, Section 6(f) of Article VII of the 1970 Illinois Constitution provides that a home-rule municipality shall have the power to provide for its officers their manner of selection and terms of office only as approved by referendum or otherwise provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to submit to the voters of the City the question of whether the current term limits of an alderman of three (3) consecutive terms should be reduced to two (2) consecutive terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: A public question shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, State of Illinois at the March 17, 2020 Presidential Primary Election, as follows:

Shall the terms of office for those persons elected to the office of alderman in the City of Rolling Meadows at the April 6, 2021 Consolidated Election, and at each election thereafter, be limited such that no person shall be eligible to seek election to or hold the office of alderman where that person has been previously elected to the office of alderman of the City of Rolling Meadows for two (2) consecutive full four (4) year terms.

SECTION TWO: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION THREE: The Deputy City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this authorizing resolution as may be required by law and to file this authorizing resolution and/or related matters with the appropriate election officials in accordance with applicable law.


