

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A LOCAL AGENCY AGREEMENT
FOR FEDERAL PARTICIPATION WITH ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
FOR PROPOSED QUENTIN ROAD BIKE PATH PROJECT
(ENGINEERING, ROW ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION AND CONSTRUCTION
ENGINEERING COSTS)**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, that the revised "Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation" between the City of Rolling Meadows and the Illinois Department of Transportation for the design engineering, right-of-way acquisition, construction and construction engineering funding for the proposed Quentin Road Bike Path project, as attached, be approved for execution. The agreement provides for a total of 80% funding by the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) (\$858,400), and 20% funding by the City of Rolling Meadows (\$214,600).


This project's local share of costs for the items defined above are provided in FY2020 Budget and will be proposed in the FY2021 Budget.


