

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING LIQUOR LICENSE TERMINATION DEADLINES
FOR CLASS A1, CLASS A2, CLASS A3 AND CLASS D LIQUOR LICENSES**

WHEREAS, due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on local businesses in the City of Rolling Meadows, and in order to promote economic development within the City, the City is desirous of providing certain relief, in the form of an extension of the duration of an existing liquor license, to holders of liquor license classifications that were most impacted by the closures and limitations on operations mandated by the stay-at-home orders issued by Governor Pritzker during the state of emergency related to COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The facts and statements contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That holders of a class A1, class A2, class A3 and class D liquor license, which license is in effect on the date of the passage of this Ordinance, shall be granted a one-time extension of an additional two (2) months on the liquor license duration applicable to their current liquor license, thereby extending the termination date of the license to 14 months from issuance of the license.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby amended to the extent of the conflict.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




