

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR CODE
TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF LICENSES PERMITTED
UNDER THE CLASS K LIQUOR LICENSE**

WHEREAS, the Rolling Meadows Liquor Code currently provides for a Class K liquor license that allows for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for a hotel that does not operate as a restaurant, but will have banquets, with food catered by others, and will have live entertainment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to amend the City's Liquor Code to increase by one (1) the number of licenses permitted under the Class K liquor license classification, establishing the total number of Class K Liquor Licenses at one (1), in order to allow for the granting of a Class K liquor license to the Aloft Hotel in Rolling Meadows, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Paragraph (a) of Section 6-37, entitled "Restriction on number and classification", of Article II, entitled "Licenses", of Chapter 6, entitled "Alcoholic Beverages", shall be amended by amending the proper numerical provision related to the Class K license, to state as follows:

One Class K license.

SECTION TWO: The issuance of the Class K liquor license to the Aloft Hotel in Rolling Meadows is contingent upon the opening of the hotel, in addition to Aloft Hotel's

satisfaction of any other requirements of the City with respect to the issuance of said liquor license.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council.


SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval and publication as provided by law.


