

RESOLUTION NO. 22-R-30

**A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE ANNUAL LIQUID
PAINT PAVEMENT STRIPING SERVICES PROJECT FOR 2022**

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director is recommending that the City's past practice of utilizing Pre-Form Traffic Control Systems, Ltd., Elk Grove Village, IL for pavement traffic control liquid paint striping be continued because of the quality of the product they offer, competitive pricing when compared to recent Municipal Partnering Initiative bids, and other benefits associated with standardization and vendor familiarity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The Rolling Meadows City Council finds the public's interest would be served by waiving a formal bidding requirement for the liquid paint striping, due to the fact that quantities are limited, and the installation and materials are specialized and allows for standardization of materials used.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, hereby approve of a contract for Liquid Paint Striping installation with Pre-Form Traffic Control Systems, Ltd., located at 625 Richard Lane, Elk Grove Village, Illinois 60007, at the prices listed as follows:

White/Yellow 4" line - \$0.12 / linear foot
White 6" line - \$0.75 / linear foot
White/Yellow 12" line - \$1.50 / linear foot
White 24" line - \$1.90 / linear foot
Letters and Symbols - \$1.90 / square foot


The contract amount shall be approved and a Purchase Order issued at an amount not to exceed \$55,000 based on the unit prices provided. Funding is to be provided as budgeted in Local Roads Fund #61.70.5010.54640
