

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR ILLINOIS TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (ITEP) FUNDS FOR EUCLID AVENUE BIKE PATH (COUNTRYSIDE PARK TO PLUM GROVE) AND LIBRARY PARKING LOT BIKE PATH CONNECTION

WHEREAS, The City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) is continuously seeking ways to improve pedestrian travel through the City’s Bike Path Plan; and

WHEREAS, federal grant funding is available through the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) which will fund 80% of the preliminary engineering, design engineering, utility relocation and construction for the project with 20% to be paid for with local funds and right of way costs shared 50%/50% between the ITEP and local funds; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in the construction of a bike path along the east side of Salt Creek adjacent to the Rolling Meadows Public Library parking lot, to connect to existing trails along Salt Creek, and complete an existing gap in the overall Salt Creek Bike Path and enhance non-motorized travel opportunities along the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the total project costs total \$1,000,300 of which the City is responsible for 20%, the City of Rolling Meadows does hereby commit funds in the amount of \$200,060 to cover its share of the preliminary engineering, design, and construction expenses; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in the construction of a bike path along the north side of Euclid Avenue between Countryside Park and Plum Grove Road to connect to existing trails along Hicks Road and along Plum Grove Road and enhance non-motorized travel opportunities along the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the total project costs for this project total \$1,013,100, the City of Rolling Meadows does hereby commit funds in the amount of \$231,120 to cover its share of the preliminary engineering, design, construction and right of way expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the agreements and other necessary documents to commit funds of \$200,060 to cover the local cost of the Public Library Parking Lot Connection and commit funds of \$231,120 for the Euclid Avenue Bike Path between Countryside Park and Plum Grove Road.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.


